‘Where is the box?’ asked Emma.



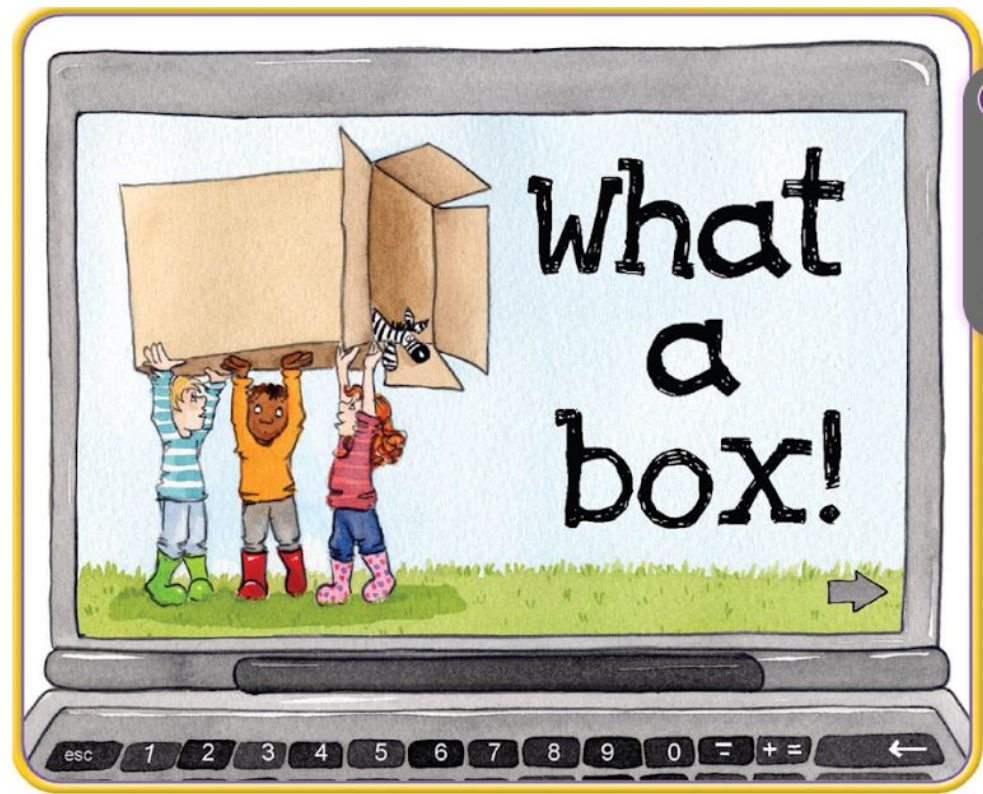
'I have something to tell you,' said Danny.

Mum said we must bring it to be recycled.'



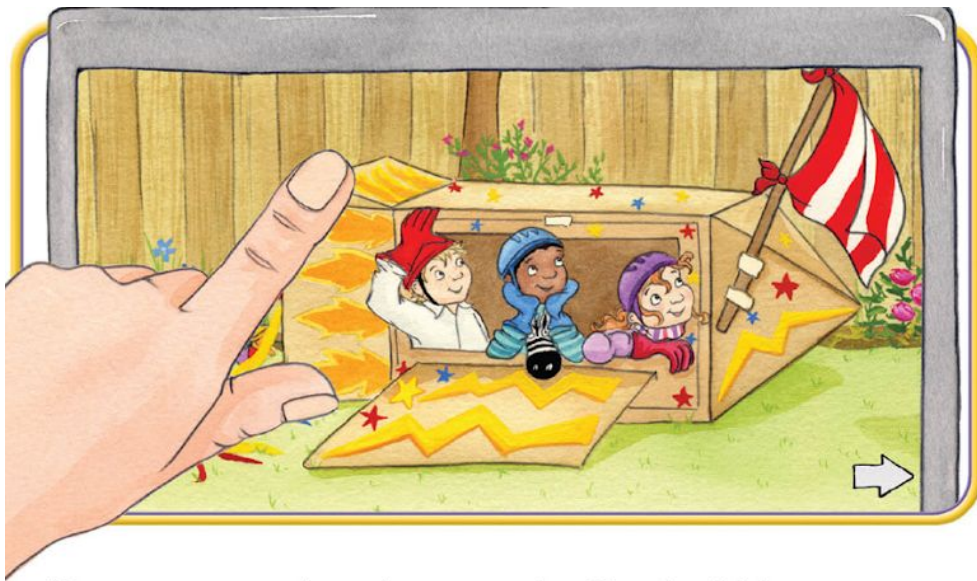
'Oh no!' said Emma.

'I have something to show you.'



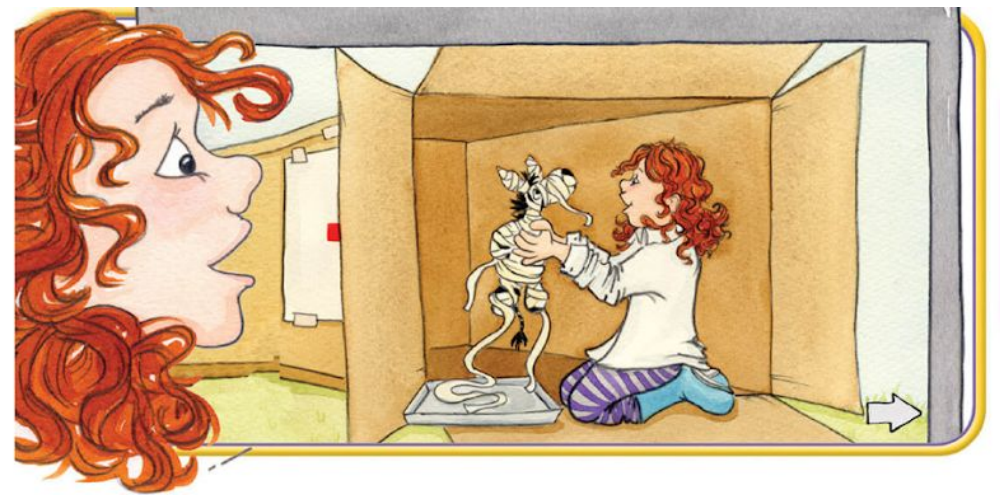
'I have photographs on my computer,' said Mum,

We were lost but Zeb had a map and we found the way home.'

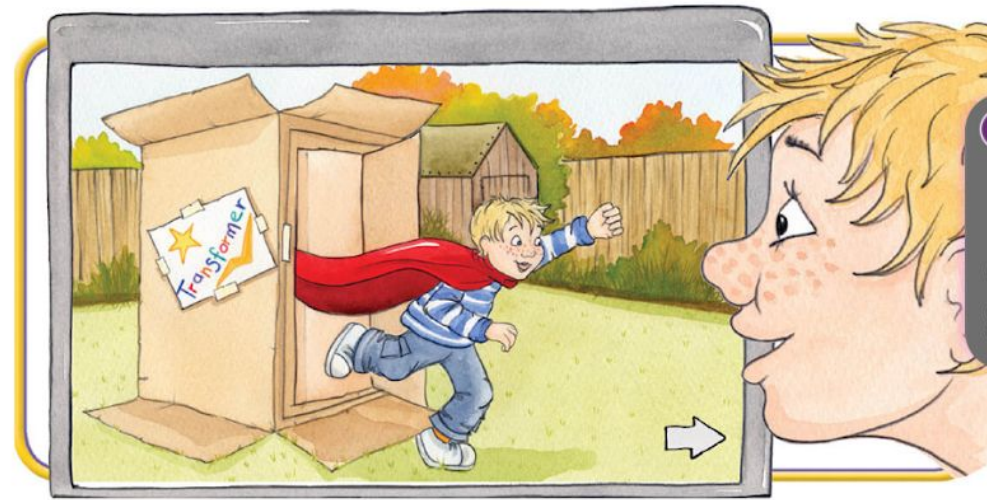


'Oh look!' said Emma. 'I remember the day that Zeb fell out of the tree and he was dizzy.

Then he got a sticker and he was happy again.'

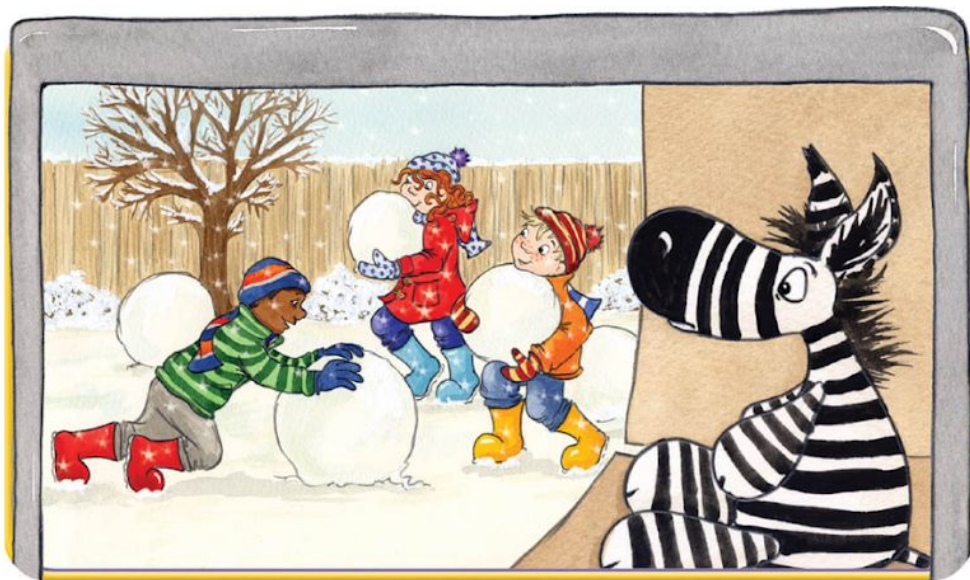


'I remember the day that Zeb was lost in the jungle,' said Josh.

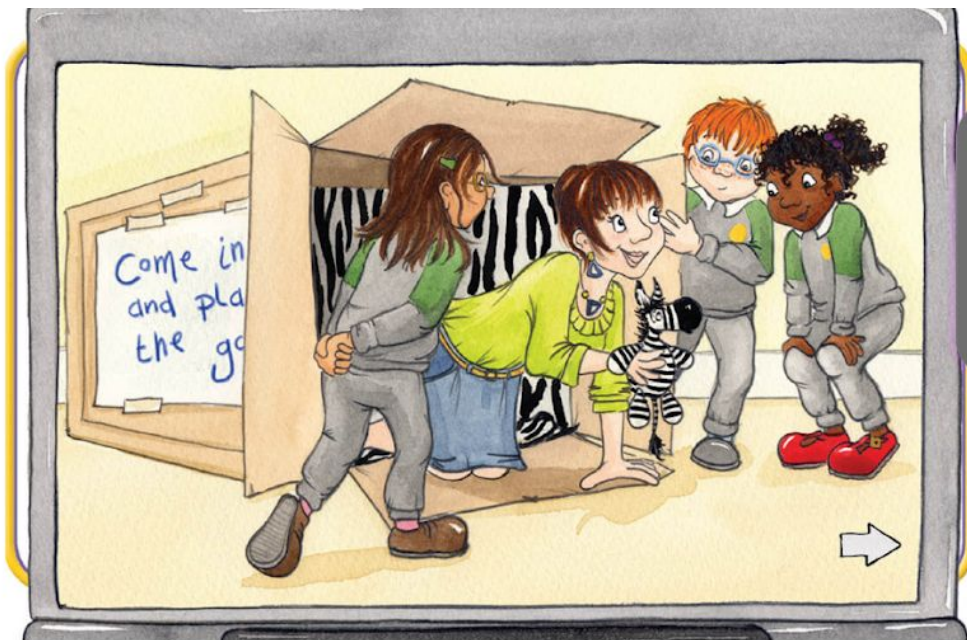

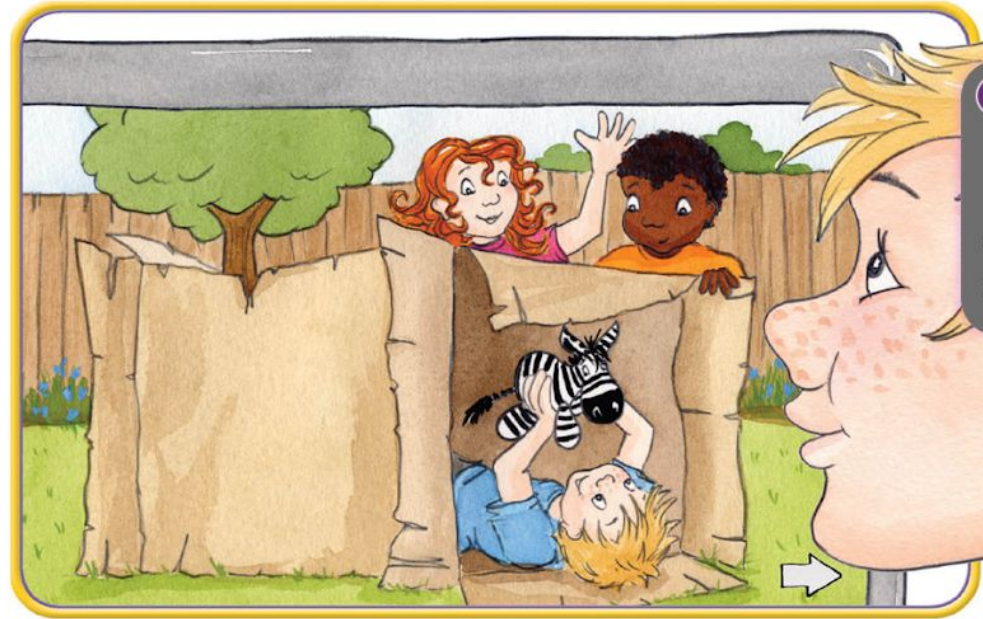
'Oh, Zeb is sad in that photograph,' said Emma.

'and soon he was happy again.'



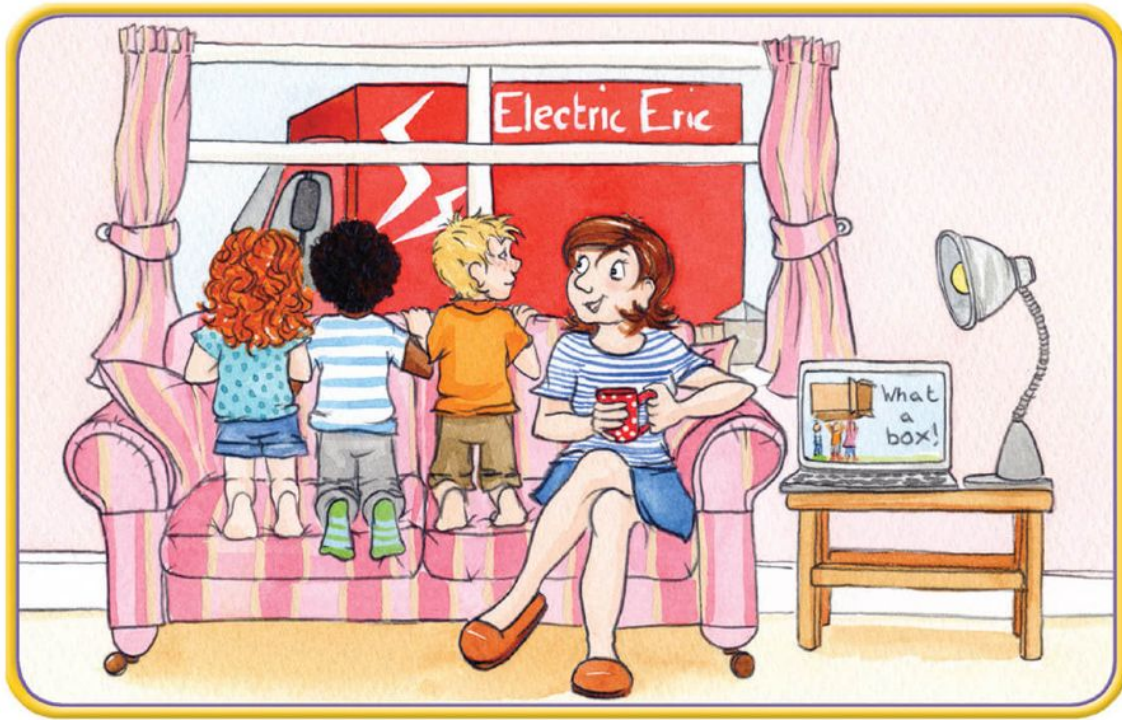
'We were in school that day,' said Josh.
