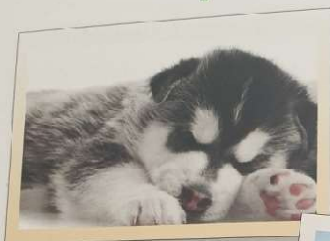


## What animal sleeps upside down?



Some animals lie down when they go to sleep.

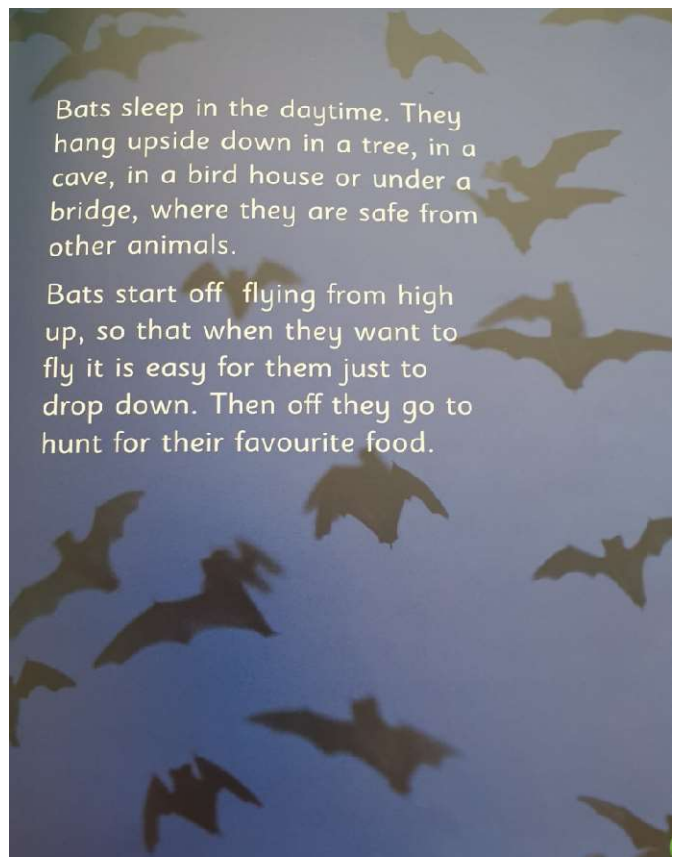
Others sleep standing up.

He used wood to make toys for his children. He made wooden bricks and cars for them.

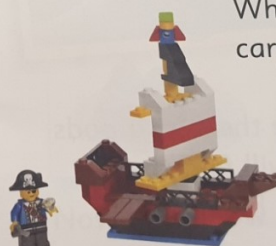

This is a cocoa tree. Cocoa trees need lots of sun and lots of rain.

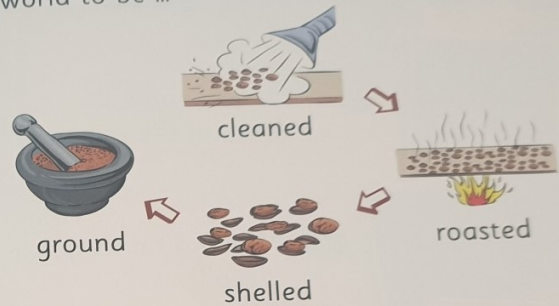
Can you see the cocoa pods on the cocoa tree? They are big and can be red, yellow or purple. About 25 pods grow on a cocoa tree.

Now you know the story of chocolate.

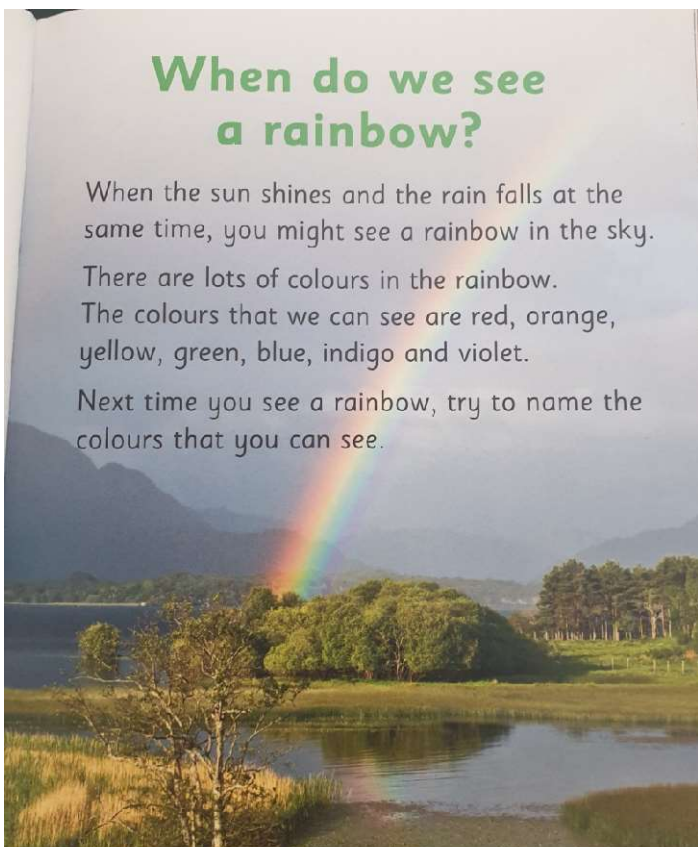
## When do we see a rainbow?
