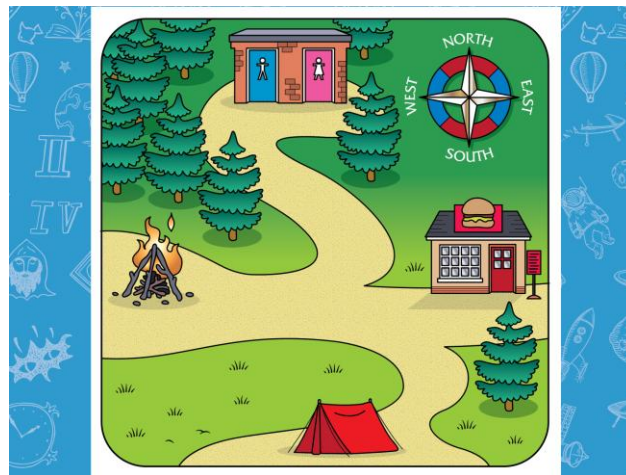


N = North
