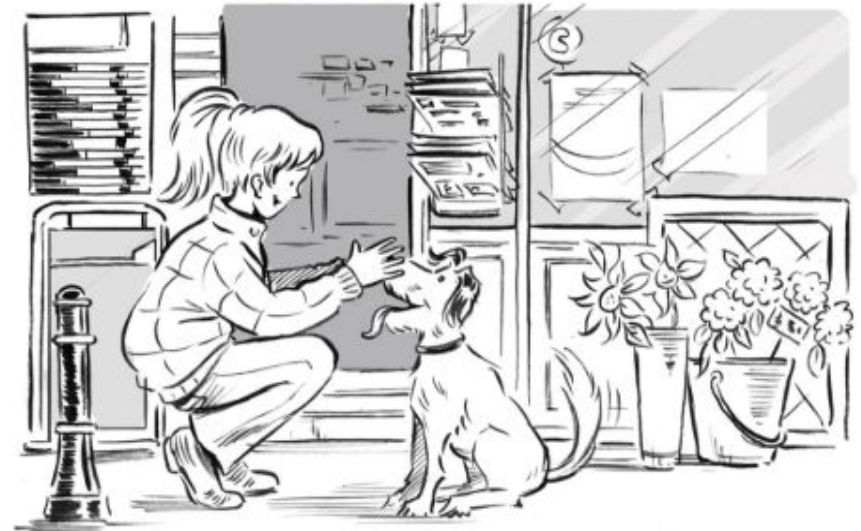
He had great fun. Then he sat down.
