I Have A Little Frog

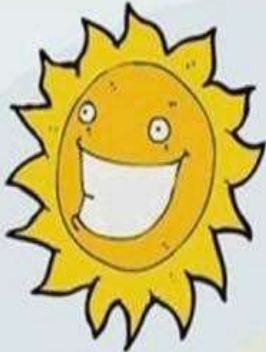
I have a little frog,

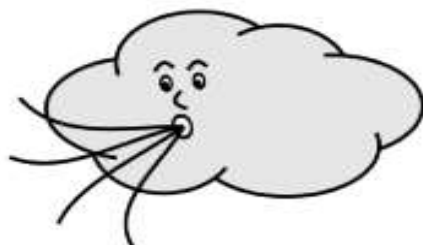

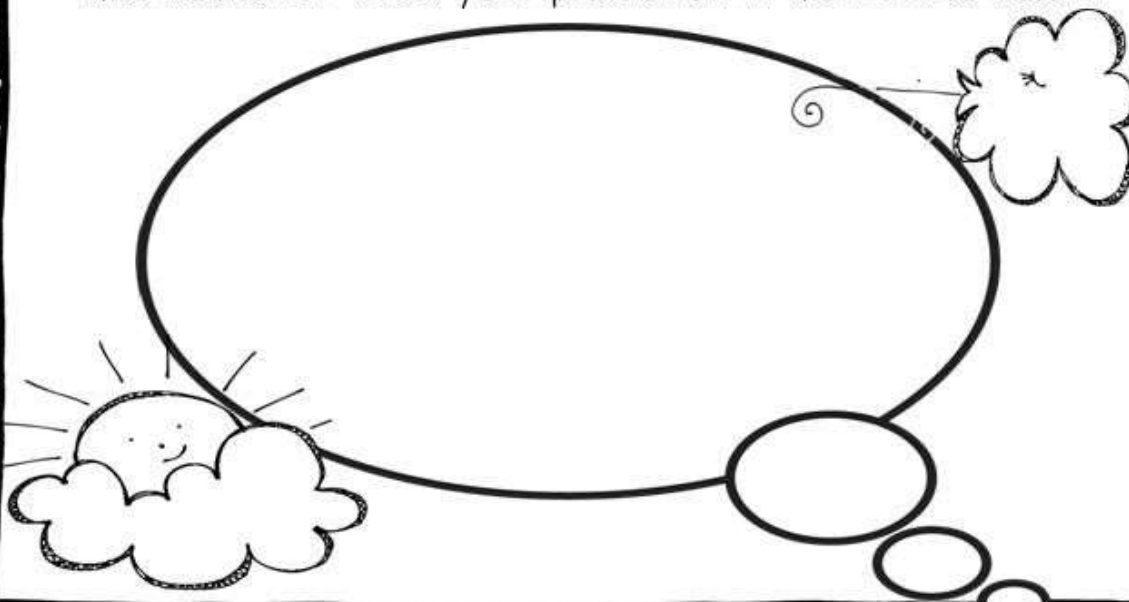
